PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

A three year programme, you will receive training in performing arts subjects leading to a certificate in **QQI Levels 2 & 3. Classes run Monday to Thursday 10am – 3pm.**

YEAR ONE

Core skills are introduced with a **QQI Level 2 General Learning Major Award** Modules in Drama, Music, Art & Design, Craft, Non Verbal Communication and Pattern & Relationship.

YEAR TWO

We develop skills; a **Foundation Level 3** programme that deepens core skills learnt in year one with the addition of Drawing, Music Appreciation, Event Participation and an end of term public performance.

YEAR THREE

We focus on practice skills. Continuation in all QQI Level 3 modules and the additions of Media Expression, Communications and Puppetry. Opportunities to learn about backstage work is also included in the final year prior to graduation.

Training is also given in dance & movement, theatre production, stage make-up, singing, film studies and literacy.
