Every theatre looks different, this is what Blue Teapot's theatre space looks like






There will be some music playing in the theatre.

If you need the toilet after the workshop, this is the door you will use in theatre.




Once you go through the door, you will see this hallway.




At the end of the hall there are two toilets.
